## **MEET OUR JUDGES**

### **OUR CONFORMATION CLASSES JUDGE**

#### **Ms Marjo Jaakkola (Finland)**



I have been involved with dogs all my life. My very first dog was a schnauzer. Then I got a bluroan Cocker Spaniel which started the love of spaniels. My first Welsh Springer Spaniel came to our home in 1980, he was an import from the UK, called Pencelli Proceed "Cymro". In 1984 I got my very own dog, he was also from the UK, INT FIN N CH NordW-86,-87 FINW-87,-88 Delkens Turul, who ended up being a top winner in the ring, the first WSS who won a group at an Int Ch show here in Finland.

He sired numerous champions. My first bitch was Russethill Remembrance, from the UK. The foundation bitches of Benton are an American import FIN & EE Ch Statesmans Unbridled and FIN CH Dons Take off to Benton. I have always been interested in other Spaniel breeds as well as Retrievers. At one point after judging that lovely breed - Golden I realised I want one.

As I cant keep many dogs at home, one thing led to another and then in 2014 Piia (now breeding under Benton prefix in partnership) and I went to pick up lovely Martha, Dewmist Duplicity after a long wait from the famous Dewmist kennels in Sweden and my dream came true, I was now a co-owner of a golden, I had the great honour to handle lovely Martha at the Golden Ring Main Championship Show in 2017 when she took BEST IN SHOW!

We have continued breeding from her with great results, along with her progeny. From this line we have now bred many Champions in both Finland and other countries.

Many Benton WSS have won numerous high awards during the years, among others INT NORD CH MultiW Benton One More Duck took CC at Crufts in 2007 (resCC in 2006) thus becoming the first foreign WSS to win

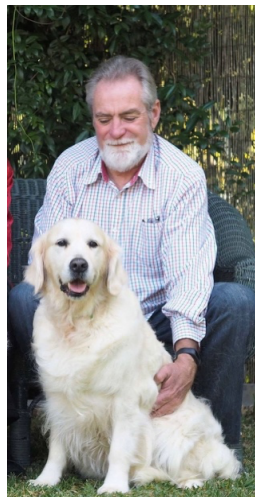
such high awards at Crufts. Benton WSS have won TOP WSS awards in numerous countries besides Finland, such as USA, Denmark, Norway, Czech Republic.

AM CH Benton Ivy League was the very first undocked WSS in the US to win all breed BEST IN SHOW.

Since 1999 I am also a Championship show judge, I can judge breeds from group 2,3,7 and 8 (whole group). I have judged in several countries, Scandinavia, Germany, Poland, Austria, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Ireland, UK, Holland, Italy, USA and Australia. I have been honoured to give tickets in WSS in the breeds country of origin already four times and I am very much looking forward to returning to the UK and judging there again at one of their Championship Shows. I also judged the Welsh Springer Spaniel Club of America National Specialty show in 2024. One of the highlights of my judging career will be judging Group 8 at European Winner Show in Sweden 2026.

## **OUR PROPERTY CLASSES JUDGE**

### **Mr Wayne McGrath “Alnclair” (NSW)**



With my wife I have been involved with Golden Retrievers since 1983 when we purchased our first puppy and quickly became involved in showing. We gained our “Alnclair” prefix in June 1985 but didn’t breed our first litter until October 1996. Over the years we have bred dozens of champions including BISS winners in Australia and New Zealand. We have also bred 5 successful Seeing Eye dogs and many dogs with obedience titles, including one who retired from the obedience ring at age 10 with his last Winner of Winners award at a National show. As we are a small breeding kennel we are extremely proud of all these achievements.

I have been judging the Gundog group at Championship level (awarding CCs to all Gundog breeds) since 2012.

As a Golden Retriever breed specialist judge I have been privileged to have judged hundreds of Golden Retrievers at some very special appointments. These include the Golden Retriever Club breed shows in Germany (FCI), South Africa, New Zealand South Island, New Zealand North Island, Western Australia and Tasmania. I was honoured to judge my own state's diamond anniversary championship show in 2024 (deferred from 2021 due to the pandemic.) I have also judged Goldens at Windsor Gundog Society Open Show in 2015 and Golden Retriever bitches at the Gundog Breeds Association of Scotland championship show in 2019. At this show my BCC winner was Best of Breed and eventually Best In Show 3 from a field of excellent entries. A very special honour was being chosen to be the Referee Judge at the 2023 GRC Scotland's Guisachan Gathering show, as well as judging the Golden Retrievers at Windsor Championship show (UK) in June 2025.

I have been a life member of our local All Breeds Club since 2003 and have held various executive positions for the club since 1983. Nearly 30 years ago I qualified as a steward and junior handler judge and am still active in these roles today as continued involvement in the dog world.

I am very honoured to be your Property Classes judge at this 2026 National show, and I wish everyone good luck and good memories.

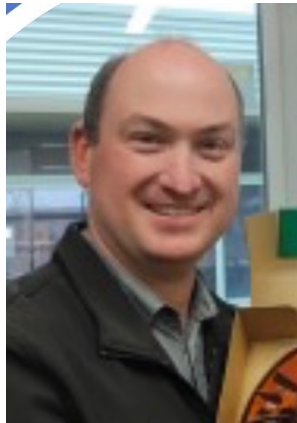

## **RETRIEVING ABILITY GUNDOG TEST JUDGE**

I am a retired school teacher and self-confessed Weimaraner addict. I purchased my first Weimaraner's in 1974 and saw my first Non-Slip Retrieving Trial (as they were called then) in 1978. Since then almost all of my Weimaraner's have tried their hand at Retrieving with varying degrees of success, My 11th Weimaraner who is now 3 years old completed her NRD title in 2025.

In 2009 I qualified to judge Novice RTFG and in 2022 was successful in upgrading my licence to judge at Restricted level.

When the Retrieving Ability Test for Gundogs rules were introduced in 2011 to replace the old Gundog Working Test I was one of the first batch of judges in South Australia to be accredited .

Since then I have judged RATG's and RTFG's regularly in South Australia. As a judge I love to see gundogs doing what they were bred for and I think that the RATG is a happy combination of basic obedience and basic retrieving exercises.

I look forward to judging the RATG at the 13th Golden Retriever National in August 2026
