General Information Herding Clinic



- The Herding Clinics run by BSDCQ and CHC have been approved by Dogs Queensland and will be conducted under the Dogs Queensland Rules and Regulations
- Clinic is open to all breeds, however preference will first be given to BSDCQ and CHC Members before opening to others
- The Committee reserves the right to reduce the number of clinic days offered if there are insufficient numbers of participants
- Clinic starts promptly at 8:00 am each day and finishes at 4:45 pm
- Lunch break will be at 12:00—12.45 pm
- Drinks will be available for sale
- Morning Tea and Lunches are included in the clinic cost —please specify any dietary requirements
- All dogs must be on a leash unless actively working in clinic arena
- Please clean up after your dogs and place bags in the provided bins
- Dogs must be up-to-date with vaccinations
- As the clinics are held on private properties, dogs should have appropriate flea/tick protection before entering
- Please bring the following items:
 - appropriate crates or accommodation for dogs when not in training arena
 - appropriate cooling and water for both humans and dogs
 - flat collar
 - long lead
 - appropriate solid footwear (no sandals)
 - a folding chair
 - hat and sunscreen
 - raincoat—in case of rain whilst in the arena
 - some gazebos will be erected, but if you want more room/shade please bring your own
- Toilets and water are available
- Camping / Accommodation may be available for long distance attendees
