





Mrs Lene Newman (UK)

“Phreelancer Collies”
Conformation Judge

It was my highest wish as a child to own a dog and my dreams came true in April 1978 when I was 12 years old and ‘Kim’ entered our lives and changed my life forever! I was soon completely smitten by the beauty, grace and gentle nature of the Collie.

I was lucky to have very supportive parents and that my rapidly growing interest in Collies was encouraged and nurtured by some notable breeders in Norway and Sweden. In 1981 I was invited to spend a few weeks with Geoff and Pat Mildon of Geoffdon fame in Britain, which was a great learning experience for me, submerged in all things Collie!

With the help of my parents and the friendships made I was lucky to travel to Britain every year to visit kennels and in 1985 I was extremely privileged to be able to stay with the Blake family for a year, although in the end it turned out to be many years as I moved over to Britain on a more permanent basis in 1988. I learnt an enormous amount during these years and will always be immensely thankful for the time spent at Corydon.

The affix ‘Freelancer’ was established in Norway in 1981 when we bred our first litter but was declined by The Kennel Club in Britain and was amended to ‘Phreelancer’. From only a handful of litters in Norway, we bred 4 champions (and other CC winners) plus owned another 4 champions. I was actively involved in the Norwegian Collie Club and was involved with both the club magazine and the breeding council. One of our Collies, our foundation bitch Nor Ch Topp-Form’s Petit Fleur won BIS all breeds which was extremely rare at the time. She was also Top Collie 1988.

Since moving to Britain, I again only bred a few litters initially, from which came the Breed Record Holder Ch Phreelancer Phrosty Moon over Corydon who was also BOB at Crufts in 2000/2001/2002. In later years, we have bred a further 3 British Champions plus CC winners and an Estonian Champion. Last year, we had the honour of being awarded Top Breeder 2024 and Top Brood 2024 and Ch Phreelancer Phaith Hill won BOB at Crufts 2024.

I have served on the committee of both British Collie Club and East Anglian Collie Association and I am currently serving on Midland Collie Club committee. I was the editor of The British Collie Club Handbook for 2 years and The International Handbook for 2 years.

I judged my first club open show in Sweden in 1984 and my first championship show in Britain in 2014. I have awarded CCs in Britain on 5 different occasions (1 general championship show and 4 club specialty championship shows) and on 3 different occasions overseas (Finland, Denmark, Norway). I am currently a mentor for the Rough Collie Breed Council where I have also been involved with the assessment of prospective judges.

Most of all, I enjoy living with our Collies on a daily basis!

Vicki is Managing Director of her own successful Dog Training Academy “Let’s Talk Dogs”. She has worked as a dog trainer for over Fifty Years, specialising in problem dogs, guard dog work and all aspects of obedience and sporting activities. Vicki started training dogs when she was only eight years old. By the age of Ten years, she was competing in obedience trials and instructing at the Eastern Suburbs Dog Training Club. At the age of fourteen Vicki gained her Dogs NSW Instructors Licence and at the age of twenty-three started Judging Obedience and Tracking and has gone on to Judged most sporting activities. Vicki has owned and trained several conformation, obedience, tracking and sporting Champions. She competes successfully on a regular basis in obedience and sporting events, and has been invited to Judge dogs regularly throughout Australia. Vicki is a full panel Obedience, Rally, Trick Dogs and Dances with Dogs judge. Vicki is a government approved Breed and Temperament assessor and works with many Councils as an Animal Advisor on Dangerous dogs. In 2010 Vicki was awarded the OAM for services to the community as a dog trainer, for charitable work with her Delta dog visiting hospitals, schools and aged care Facilities and particularly for her work with the Royal New South Wales Canine Council.
