Conditions Of Entry

All competitors, essential helpers, event officials and volunteers must carefully read.

All must abide by the following measures at all times whilst on the grounds (KCC, Bulla) , failure to comply with the following Covid-19 Rules will result in removal from the competition and grounds.

To promote a safe competition environment the Chihuahua Club Inc has put the following rules in place.

Please ensure you check the current VIC Government guidelines before submitting entries and / or attending the event.

NO SPECTATORS are permitted to these events until advised accordingly by Dogs Victoria.

If you have not been well or have a temperature of 37.5 or above PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND.

Hygiene and Hand Washing: -

- Hand sanitiser will be available throughout the venue and bathrooms, please use it regularly and before touching taps, please also practice good hand washing’.
- Bathrooms will be cleaned by Dog Vic’s contracted cleaners throughout the day, density limits in toilets are 4 people at any one time. Other common surfaces will be sanitised at regular intervals.
- The sharing of equipment is NOT PERMITTED.
- Exhibit numbers and catalogue will be emailed to reduce any transmission of the virus.
- There will be no place ribbons available for all of these events.
- The exhibitors shall be responsible for mouthing their own show entered dogs.

Physical Distancing: -

- Physical distancing of 1.5 metres must be maintained at all times.
- Gazebo’s must be spaced a minimum of 1.5 metres apart.
- Only members of the same household can share a gazebo.
- Ring gates must be entered one at a time to maintain social distancing, please use the exit gate after judging.
- While waiting for classes, ringside exhibitors and helpers must adhere to social distancing rules.
- Exhibitors shall stand at arm’s length from their dog as it is being examined by the judge to assist in maintaining physical distancing.
- A face mask must be carried at all times and worn when physical distancing cannot be obtained.
