

#### FCI Classes explained.

Classes in which the CACIB cannot be awarded:

Class 1 - Baby Puppy: For dogs aged three and under six months.

Class 2 - Minor Puppy: For dogs aged six and under nine months.

Class 3 - Puppy: For dogs aged six and under twelve months.

#### Classes in which the CACIB can be awarded:

**Class 4 - Junior:** For dogs aged nine and under eighteen months. (Providing the winner is over 15 months of age)

**Class 5 - Intermediate:** For dogs aged eighteen and under thirty-six months.

Class 6 - Open: For dogs 15 months and over that are not Champions

Class 7 - Champion: To enter a dog in Champion Class, the title must have been confirmed by the issue of a Registered Pedigree Certificate with the title added by the day of the official closing date of entries.

Note: A Champion that has not attained 15 months of age may not be awarded a CACIB.
