**Order of judging**: Interiors and vehicles will be run at the same time. Competitors doing both will run interiors first and then move down to vehicles. Exteriors will be run at the conclusion of interiors. (Probably after a lunch break)

Scents to be used: Masters (birch, cypress and clove) .Excellent (birch, clove, cypress).

Trial will commence 10am. Check in 9am to 9.30am. Competitor briefing at 9.45am
