New Class: Class 18 & 18a Open Neuter *Eligible for Neuter Challenge & BOB*

The Special Classes are to be pre-entered; no entries on the day of the show

- 13 Brace** For two exhibits six months of age or over, each of which has competed in at least one ordinary class at the same exhibition and is the property of the same owner and is handled in the judging ring by the one person.
- 15 Team** For three or more exhibits six months of age or over, each of which has competed in at least one ordinary class at the same exhibition and is the property of the same owner and is handled in the judging ring by the one person.
- 19 Interstate Bred**
- 24 Parent / Progeny** (maximum of four (4) progeny)
- 26 Best Headed**
- 27 Best Gaited**
