CONFORMATION CLASSES: Baby Puppy - 3 months and under 6 months, Minor Puppy - 6 months and under 9 months, Puppy - 9 months and under 12 months, Junior - 12 months and under 18 months, Intermediate - 18 months and under 24 months, Open - 24 months and over. (Ages at first day of show – 11th March 2023)

JUDGING TIMES:

SATURDAY - Vest collection from 8.30 am. All Baby Puppy to Intermediate Classes. Judging will commence at 9.00am, with all Long Stock Coat Bitch classes, followed by all Long Stock Coat Dog classes, followed by all Stock Coat Bitch classes, followed by all Stock Coat Dog classes.

Sires Progeny Parade, Dams Progeny Parade, and Breeders Groups will follow Long Stock Coat Classes.

SUNDAY Vest collection from 8.30 am. All Open Classes. Judging will commence at 9.00am, with Long Stock Coat Open Bitch and Open Dog individuals followed by Stock Coat Open Bitch and Open Dog individuals. Off-lead gaiting will be conducted during all Open Bitch and Open Dog classes. Gun Testing may be conducted in all Open Classes. Veterans Parade, followed by Open Class run-offs – LSC Bitches, LSC Dogs, SC Bitches, SC Dogs. Junior Handlers judged during Lunch-break.

SIRES AND DAMS PROGENY PARADE: Entry is automatic. A minimum of 5 progeny aged 4 months or over and entered in Conformation classes will be automatically catalogued with the Sires/Dams name. Sire/Dam need not be present or entered in the show. Only Sires/Dams classified under the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme (or other GSDCA approved scheme) are eligible.

BREEDERS GROUP: Each Breeders Group must consist of five (5) animals from more than one sire or dam and be 9 months or older. Entry form required (no fee) by Close of Entries and is a competitive class.

VETERANS PARADE: Exhibits to be 7 years of age or over and be Breed Surveyed, graded Excellent or achieved an Obedience Title. A resume (not exceeding 400 words) including the name of the Exhibit must be submitted to the Show Secretary by **20th February 2023** (no fee). The class is non-competitive, and a commemorative sash will be presented to all participants.

GRADINGS: Will be awarded at the Judge's discretion: 'Promising' and 'Very Promising' in Baby, Minor and Puppy classes. 'Good' and 'Very Good' in Junior, Intermediate and Open classes. The gradings of 'Excellent' and 'Excellent Merit' will only be awarded to exhibits 24 months and over who are Breed Survey classified and entered in the Open classes.

CATERING: Available

SPECIAL PRIZES: Trophy and Sash to 'State Sieger' and 'State Siegerin' (both varieties), all Class Winners and Breeders Group Winner. Sashes for first to fifth place. Trophy and Sash for Best Dual Performance Exhibit. All Conformation trophies will be presented at the Official Presentations and Show Summation, after the conclusion of judging on Sunday 12th March, 2023.

Note: The titles of Sieger and Siegerin will be awarded at the Judge's discretion and will NOT be restricted to Victorian domiciled animals.

ENTRY FEES: Initial Entry - \$25.00 (Includes Catalogue). Subsequent Entry - \$20.00. Baby Puppy, Minor Puppy and Puppy – Initial Entry - \$20.00, Subsequent Entry - \$15.00. Please show any Titles, Breed Survey status, Hip and Elbow status etc., on entry to enable inclusion in catalogue. **NOTE: Exhibits over 2 years of age must enter in Open class, and forward a copy of 5 generation pedigree and copy of Hip/Elbow Status to the Show Secretary (either by post or email) by Close of Entries (27th February, 2023).** Legible paperwork must be received by close of entries, otherwise entry will be rejected. No entry fee for Veterans Parade or Breeders Group.
