Additional Information

- Dogs ACT reserves the right to make any changes that will ensure the smooth conduct of the trial, to substitute or appoint
 additional judges and to accept or reject entries
- A separate entry form must be submitted for each entry (Scent Work Rules: s8.1.2)
- Competitors must only enter the classes they are eligible to enter (Scent Work Rules: s6.1 and s6.2)
- Competitors should not visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.
- Spectators will only be permitted for Excellent and Masters (space permitting and at the judges discretion). Any spectator
 will have to remain at the spectator location for the duration of the class, with no speaking, no food and no drinks.
- No cars will be permitted to move around the venue between check in times. Any late arrivals will need to park at the
 entrance to the camp and walk in.
- Telstra phones are the only phones that will work at the campgrounds due to the poor reception in the area.
- Please pick up all poo and place it in the bins on the grounds.
- Multiple large campfires are available for use at night time bring your marshmallows.
- Please only use the adult bathroom facilities and not the youth bathroom facilities.

Balloting of entries:

- If you have entered your dog in 4 elements (ie. novice containers, vehicles, interiors and exteriors) your exhibit number will be placed in a hat.
- Numbers will be drawn out and recorded in order until the required number is reached.
- You will be notified by email that you have been balloted out of 1 element.
- Each competitor will only be balloted out of 1 element max.
- Your exhibitor number will then be placed at the bottom of the catalogue in the order you were drawn in the ballot.
- On the day of the trial, at the close of check-in, if there are absentees, handlers who have been balloted out will be offered a run in that element, in the order they were drawn in the ballot.
- If your dog is not offered a run, your will be given a cash refund on the day.

UPGRADES: may be allowed only if numbers in the higher classes permit. Upgrades must be made <u>online through Show</u> <u>Manager</u> **until 1 APRIL 2023**. Upgrades after this date need to be advised to the trial manager at jwashingtonking@bigpond.com. Only 1 upgrade per element per dog is allowed. Constant changes won't be accepted.
