- Competitors should not visit the trial location for scent work training prior to the trial date
- There must be only one dog and handler per class. Any owner entering two dogs in the same class must advise the name of a second handler (who must be registered with a member body). Dogs from the same family will be run concurrently.
- **No target odour to be brought to the grounds**
- **Bitches in Oestrus may not be trialed**
