Track and Search - Equipment

The rules around acceptable Track and Search Equipment in ANKC Trials has changed.



A summary outline is as below:

Leads

- 1. Leads must be 5-6m in length (they cannot be shorter or longer than this)
- 2. Leads must be reflective for night tracks (6, 8, 10)

Harnesses

- 3. Harnesses must be non-restrictive (Y shaped preferred)
- 4. Harnesses must be high-visibility for all tracks
- 5. Harnesses must be high-visibility and reflective for all night tracks (6, 8, 10)
- 6. A <u>light</u> attached to the harness is desirable for night tracks some judges will request a light
- 7. If the harness is <u>not</u> high-visibility and reflective then a <u>high-visibility</u> and reflective shirt or vest should be worn by the dog

Collars

- 8. A flat collar with an id-tag can be worn on all tracks but it should not interfere with the harness or the movement of the dog
- 9. A tick Collar may be worn

It has been agreed that existing leads and harnesses may be retro-fitted to match the criteria above. This includes the addition of reflective and high-visibility material to leads and harnesses that you already own.
