The title **State Sieger and State Siegerin** may be awarded to the winner of the Open Dog and Bitch, for both varieties. Only when graded an Excellent Merit.

Gradings: will be awarded at the Judge's discretion: 'Promising' and 'Very Promising' in Baby, Minor and Puppy classes. 'Good' and 'Very Good' in Junior, Intermediate and Open class. The gradings of 'Excellent' and 'Excellent Merit' will only be awarded to exhibits 24 months and over and exhibited in the Open classes.

GSDCA Excellent Merit grading: May only be awarded to animals exhibited in the Open Class and successfully GSDCA Breed Survey Classified, or equivalent as recognised by the GSDCA; animals that the judge considers to be of high anatomical worth, type, quality and have a potential for or have demonstrated attributes that will produce animals that are of above, or far above average, in terms of type and quality. Size for males up to and including 66cms and females up to and including 61cms.

<u>GSDCA Excellent grading</u>: May only be awarded in the Open Class and to animals that are successfully classified through the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme, or recognised as such by the GSDCA.

Obedience Classes – Excellent awards are awarded to dogs that score 95 or more in CCD and any Rally class and 190 or more in Novice, Open, UD or UDX classes.

Grading Certificates: To all eligible graded animals. Gradings are only awarded at the judge's discretion.

TOP SHOW & OBEDIENCE TROPHIES CLASSES (See catalogue for full details):

Junior – For all animals in Training (Graduation) Classes, i.e. Pre-Kindy to Class One and of any age in any Baby to Open Conformation Classes.

Senior – For all animals in Trials (Obedience) Classes, i.e. CCD upwards and over 6 months of age in the Minor to Open Classes.

LADY OBEDIENCE HANDLER CLASS (Entry into this class is free):

Dianne Roberts Memorial Competition. Handler will be judged on handling ability only at Novice standard. Entries to be given to Jean McCowan with appropriate filled in entry.

JUNIOR HANDLERS IN OBEDIENCE (Entry into this class is free):

Children between the ages of 7 and 19 years, inclusive, are able to compete in their own obedience class. They must have attended at least three (3) obedience training classes to be eligible to enter. They will be judged at Pre-Kindy level.

JUNIOR HANDLERS IN CONFORMATION (Entry into this class is free):

Children between the ages of 7 and 19 years, inclusive, are able to compete in their own conformation class (7 to under 10 years, or 10 to under 13 years, or 13 to under 19 years). They must not take Bitches in season into the competition. They will be judged commensurate with ANKC Junior Handler and GSDCA Junior Showmanship levels. These classes can be entered on the day. Entries, showing full name and age, to be provided to the Show Gate Steward.

SPECIAL CLASSES (Non Competitive)

VETERANS PARADE

For Animals over 7 years of age. Exhibits in the Veteran Class must be entered by close of entries. Please include a resume of the dog's sire and dam, titles, qualifications and past achievements. Entry into this class is free.

CRITIQUE ONLY CLASS

A Critique of your dog by a Breed Specialist Judge(s) will be made available.

The assessment is not open to dogs being exhibited in a Conformation Class or those that have been Breed Surveyed. Please provide a five (5) generation pedigree, if available.

- 1. The State Breed Exhibition is for members of the GSDA of WA (Inc) and members of the German Shepherd Dog Clubs affiliated with The German Shepherd Dog Council of Australia
- 2. A seperate form is required for each class entered, i.e. if a dog is entered in both obedience and show, a seperate entry form is required for each Class.
- 3. Exhibitors are requested to show their dog's titles, Breed Survey classification, HD and Elbow classification and H-neg where applicable for males, on the entry form so that they can be included in
