weather forecast), human backpack, food & drink, sunscreen, hat, insect repellant, etc.

Please pre-load & weigh your dog's backpack to roughly the correct weight at home.


Weather policy: Weather policy is in accordance with the ANKC Sled Sports Rules and Dogs Victoria extreme weather policy.
