Trial starts not before 11 am with a handler briefing. (If set up has not been completed, the start may be delayed)
Classes: under $30 \mathrm{~cm}, 30 \mathrm{~cm}$ - under45cm, $45 \mathrm{~cm}+$
Dogs must be over 12 months of age to participate.
Entry Fee: \$15. Enter Via Showmanager.
Entries close 20 April or when the maximum number has been reached.

## About this event: PLEASE READ

- A maximum of 2 entries (dogs) per owner/s allowed, to ensure as many people as possible get a chance to enter.
- Entries will be capped at 50 as this is the first ACT Sprint event and we are still learning how to put this event on.
- This event is open to all dogs that are registered with an ANKC member body (i.e. main / limited register, associate register, or sporting register).
- As this is a Mock trial, no results will be available.
- Dogs run individually after a plastic lure down a straight course and are timed.
- The sprint track is surrounded by barrier mesh.
- One handler releases the dog, and another handler catches the dog at the end of the track.
- People entering the event, need to organise their own handlers.
- All handlers must be a minimum age of 16 yrs old and a financial member of an ANKC member body (ie Dogs ACT, Dogs NSW)
- All dogs will run in the first round and those that successfully complete their first run will be eligible for the second round.
- Dogs may run naked or in a flat collar, with no hanging tags.
- Bitches in season are not allowed on the grounds.
- No pregnant bitches or bitches under 12 wks post whelp may enter.
- Dogs must be on lead and under effective control when off the sprint track.
- Prior to entering, ensure your dog is fit, healthy and without injury.
- Ensure dogs are warmed up and cooled down for each run.
