Unofficial Sprint Trial

When – Saturday 29 June 2024

Where – Companion Dog Club Grounds

Narrabundah Lane, Symonston, ACT

Check in 09.15 to 09.45 am (anyone not checked in will be marked absent)

Dog measuring 09.15 to 09.35 - only for dogs that don't have a height card from any dog sport and you are unsure of which height group it is in. A Sprint Dog height card is only valid for Sprint Dog.

Trial starts not before 10 am with a handler briefing. (Start time dependant on set up completion and frost/fog)

Dog Height: under 30cm, 30cm – under45cm, 45cm & over, unmeasured.

Dogs must be over 12 months of age to participate.

Entry Fee: \$15. Enter Via Showmanager. Will open 31 May.

Entries close: 9am on 25 June. No refunds after entries closed.

About this event: **PLEASE READ**

- Entries will be capped at 70.
- No more than one dog per exhibitor (includes joint owners/co-owners or dogs that reside with you but are in someone else's name).
- This event is open to all dogs that are registered with an ANKC member body (i.e. main / limited register, associate register, or sporting register).
- As this is a Mock trial, no results will be available on the day
- Dogs run individually after a lure down a straight course and are timed.
- One handler releases the dog, and another handler catches the dog at the end of the track.
- People entering the event, need to organise their own handlers.
- The name of your handler can be added in showmanager when entering.
- All handlers must be a minimum age of 16 yrs old and a financial member of an ANKC member body (ie Dogs ACT, Dogs NSW)
- All dogs will run in the first round and those that successfully complete their first run will be eligible for the second round.
- Dogs may run naked or in a flat collar, with no hanging tags.
- Bitches in season are not allowed on the grounds.
- No pregnant bitches or bitches under 12 wks post whelp may enter.
- Dogs must be on lead and under effective control when off the sprint track.
- Prior to entering, ensure your dog is fit, healthy and without injury.
- Ensure dogs are warmed up and cooled down for each run.
