SHOW REGULATIONS

1. All dogs entered in a Sanctioned Show or Trial must be registered with, and owners be financial members of a State Controlling Body affiliated with the Australian National Kennel Council or the N.Z. Kennel Club.
2. In order to enter for any Sanctioned Show, Trial or Test in Western Australia, persons normally resident in Western Australia must be financial members the Canine Association of Western Australia (Inc).
3. No dog may be entered in a Sanctioned Event unless it is registered and/or transferred to the owner before 5.00 pm on the Monday, the closing date of that particular show. It is the owner's responsibility to verify that the transaction has been effected.
4. It is the owner's responsibility to see that all dogs are entered in their correct class.
5. Entries may be refused if not made out in accordance with the rules of the Canine Association of Western Australia (Inc).

Governing Council advises action may be taken against owners contravening these regulations.

NOTE: "Sanctioned Event" means any Championship Show, Open Show, Parade, Retrieving Trial, Obedience Trial, Tracking, DWD, Rally O, Field, Agility Trial, Herding Trial or Endurance Test. It does not include Members Competitions, for which exhibitors must be members of the Club conducting the event, but need not necessarily a member of the CAWA.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO CLUB SECRETARIES

Schedules

- Approval of special classes must be have been granted by Governing Council before the Schedule is submitted.
 - When a Club wishes to contract an Overseas Judge, approval must be applied for **at least nine (9) months prior** to the proposed engagement. This approval must have to have been granted before the Schedule is submitted.
 - All schedules must be submitted for approval **at least 4 months prior to the date of the event**
 - Please submit **2** copies of the schedule to the CAWA office.
 - All schedules **must** be accompanied by:
 - a) All Judging Contracts, signed by judge and club secretary
 - b) Venue Booking forms (if at Canine Centre)
 - c) Advertising Fees
- Incomplete schedules will **NOT** be accepted.
- Publication details (i.e. size, issue or NFP) must be completed.
 - Late copy, fax copy and hand written copy will **NOT** be accepted.
 - Fines may be issued to Clubs that breach the Regulations pertaining to the submission of schedules.

Canine News

- Closing date of submissions for Canine News is approximately six (6) weeks preceding the date of issue. i.e.

This applies to all items including amendments to submitted schedules.

- Event schedules where entries close in the first 21 days of the month of Canine News issue will **NOT** be accepted for publication.

Fun SprintDog™ Event

What is SprintDog : SprintDog is a fun event that anyone can have a go at. Dogs are timed chasing after a plastic lure for 100 meters. Dogs are categorised into 3 classes depending on their height, these categories then have handicaps. Your dog will run twice (see Eligibility) and their time averaged and handicap applied. A result is given in Km/h. The Sprint field is surrounded by bunting. For quick transition between dogs, you will need 2 handlers, someone to release and someone to catch the dog. As the dog will enter one end and exit at the other. Each person requires a lead. When to arrive: Gates will open at approx 4pm for set up, this will depend on when the trials and conformation showing is finished. This sport has a lot to set up (many hands mean light work), please don't bring your dogs to setup area they must be secured in a wire crate, dog trailer or vehicle. Check in is from 5pm-5.45pm Dogs will need to be measured unless they hold an official Dogs Australia height card (this card will need to be presented). First runs will take place at 6pm. (DogsWest heat policy will apply to this event and the start time may be pushed back) Eligibility of dog: Dogs must be 9 months or older to compete. Dogs 9-12 months old can only do 1 run. Dogs 12 months and older can do 2 runs. Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds. Dogs can run in a flat collar only, no choke chains, prong collars or e-collars are permitted. Dogs must be on leash at all times when not running in the sprint zone. Cost: Members of AABDC \$15per dog, Non members \$20 per dog (regardless of age of dog) Entries will be capped at 60 dogs. No refunds will be offered. A run sheet will be uploaded to our Facebook page the day before the event. Times will be calculated and uploaded to our Facebook page the day after the event. No presentations will occur on the night.

this trial will be run as a fun event for Albany members to enter and watch, there will be some spots for show people as well but will be capped at 60 dogs.

We hope that this will create enough interest to be something our club can run in the future, it will not be run while the show is on, but held at the end of the second show and after trailing has finished on Saturday starting at approx 6pm, there will be set up and pack away which we would love if all show people on the grounds could help with.
