

SprintDog ™ Restricted Trial Saturday 16 November 2024 (evening trial)

Venue: Companion Dog Club Grounds, Narrabundah Lane, Symonston, ACT

Trial is restricted to:

- Persons/dogs living within the ACT or within 50km of Canberra (see map at bottom of schedule)
- Dogs that have not qualified for a SprintDog Title (don't have 100pts yet)
- All entries that do not comply with the above requirements will be rejected.

Entries close Monday 11 November 2024 at 7.00 am

Entry fee: \$20.00 (includes a \$2 equipment fundraising levy).

Online entries only, via Showmanager.

No changes after close of entry.

Trial entries capped at 40 dogs and limited to one entry per person. This may be increased to two dogs, if space allows. No dog can be entered in both the morning trial and this trial.

Class: 100m Sprint.

Judge: Liz Hindley (ACT)

Lure Driver: Helen Mosslar (ACT)

This trial will be using a continuous lure and have an enclosed catching pen.

Judging starts: 5.00pm

Check-in and measuring: between 4.15 to 4.45pm.

Vetting: There will be no vetting at check-in, but organisers reserve the right to vet any dog if it deems

necessary.

Catalogue / running sheet: provided free on the Canberra SprintDog Facebook page.

Awards: Qualification Certificates and ribbons.

Important additional information (Please read).

- Dogs entered in the morning trial, cannot be entered in this trial.
- Owners can only enter 2 dogs in today's events, i.e. if you have 1 dog in this trial, you can enter 1
 different dog in the morning trial or if you have 2 dogs in this morning's trial, you can't enter this
 trial.
- Restrictions on entries might be lifted if space permits.
- Exhibitors to bring their dogs height card. Dogs without a card to be measured at check-in.
- Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers.
- As per SprintDog Rules, all handlers must be financial members of their state member body and handlers must be over 16 years of age.
- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in showmanager to aid with cataloguing.
- All dogs will run in the first round. Dogs that do not complete the course, will not be eligible to compete in the second round.
- Bitches in season are not allowed on the club grounds.
- The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.
- The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.
- If the temperature reaches 32 °C the running of the trial will be suspended or delayed.
- Entries are restricted to Dogs ACT members (ie ACT residents) or NSW members who live within 50km of Canberra City (as per the map below) who's dog does not yet have their Novice SD title. Any entry that does not comply with this, will be rejected.
