To encourage Group B dogs to participate, releasers may choose to run up the track with their dog or the catcher may come closer than 100m (timing may not be possible for these runs)

What To Bring:

- 2 sets of flat collars and leads, or slip leads - one for the releaser and one for the catcher. Dogs need to run naked or with a flat collar. Collars must not have handles, tags, or other parts that can get snagged.
- Number holders or pins for both the releaser and catcher.
- Another handler to be your releaser - this can be organised on the day but you must name someone at check-in (they must be able to handle your dog).
- Water bowl - taps on site
- Food - no canteen. Cans of drink for sale (\$3 - cash only)
- Crate - Dogs must be crated or safely contained in cars (No tethering permitted) away from the sprint track and out of bounds area, unless warming up away from the trial area or until your number has been called.
- Shade and sunscreen - limited picnic table huts on ground
- Information for height card: DOGSNSW registered dog number, name, breed, and DOB. Those not registered with DOGSNSW cannot get an official card for use at trials.

Must be a member of DOGSNSW or Newcastle All Breeds Dog Training Club to enter.

ENTRIES VIA SHOWMANAGER - OPEN MONDAY 17TH FEBRUARY. CLOSE MONDAY 24TH FEBRUARY. ENTRY: \$15 - LIMIT OF 1 DOG PER OWNER.

INCORRECT ENTRIES WILL BE DELETED.
