Venue: Belconnen Dog Club Grounds, Mitchell

Class: 100m Sprint.

Entries close 09.00am Tuesday 8 April 2025

Entry fee: \$20.00 (includes a \$2 equipment fundraising levy).

No refunds after close of entry.

Online entries only, via Showmanager

Trial A (restricted) – entries capped at 50 dogs, restricted to people living within the area identified in the attached map (see below in additional information) and limited to two entries per person (showmanager profile)

Trial B - entries capped at 50 dogs and limited to two entries per person (showmanager profile)

Lure Drivers: Trial A – Helen Mosslar (ACT) Trial B – Belinda Mitchell (NSW)

These trials will be using a continuous lure and have an enclosed catching pen.

Check-in: 8.00 to 8.45am. Anyone not checked in will be marked absent.

Measuring Dogs: 8.00 to 8.45am. Owners will need to fill in the height card before presenting the dog for measurement. Blank height cards will be available on the day.

Vetting: There will be no vetting at check-in, but organisers reserve the right to vet any dog if it deems necessary.

Judging starts: 9.15am

Run Order: Run 1 Trial A dogs then Trial B dogs, followed by Run 2 Trial A dogs then Trial B dogs.


Awards: Qualification Certificates and ribbons.

Important additional information (Please read).

- Entries limited to only two entries per person for the day. This restriction might be lifted if space permits.
- No Dog can be entered in both Trial A and Trial B.
- All dogs will run in the first round. Dogs that do not complete the course, will not be eligible to compete in the second round.
- Exhibitors to bring their dogs height card. Dogs without a card to be measured at check-in.
- Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers.
- All handlers must be financial members of their state member body. Handlers must be over 16 years of age.
- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in showmanager to aid with cataloguing.



- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete or allowed on the club grounds.
- Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete.
- The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.
- The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.
- This trial may stop as per the rules, if the temperature reaches over 32°
- This trial is run under the rules & regulations of Dogs ACT.
- Entries into Trial A are restricted to people living within the area identified below (110km from Canberra City) plus anyone living in the south coast area from Batemans Bay to Eden (includes Cooma to Bega) (the address listed in showmanger will be used to accept or reject entries).

• Waitlist – will be run via Showmanager, for anyone that is not successful in getting an entry in due to the maxium entries being met before closing. The waitlist will be drawn and if any vacent places become available they will be offered in the order of the drawn list. Only one waitlist ticket per person. Mulitplies will be excluded from the draw.
