Parks Victoria Grade 3 Track: Tracks may have short
steep sections, a rough surface and many steps.

Check in: 7.30 - 8.30 am

Hike starts: 9.00 am sharp

dog, fit & adjust the backpack and get ready.*

Hike Distance: 16-17 km (allow 5-7 hours including rest stops)

Backpack hire: There are limited backpacks available for hire— please contact the backpacking coordinator to pre-book a
backpack. Please provide the breed and weight of your dog to determine pack size.

ANCK Rules: This event is conducted under the Dogs Australia Sled Sports rules. Rules can be downloaded from the Dogs
Australia website: dogsaustralia.org.au/media/10214/19-da-sled-sports-event-rules-01-01-25.pdf

Eligibility: Restricted to ANCK registered dogs eighteen months of age and over.

Only dogs weighing over 10 kg are eligible. Exclusions: Brachycephalic & Achondroplastic breeds
All handlers must be members of an ANCK member body and a minimum of 16 years of age.

Maximum 2 dogs per handler

What to bring: PLEASE BRING SUFFICIENT WATER AND FOOD FOR YOURSELF AND YOUR DOG

There is no water or catering available at the hike venue.

Sturdy lead & collar, suitable canine backpack, weight for the backpack (pre-weighed), water & water bowl for
your dog, basic first aid items, rubbish bags, appropriate clothing & footwear, warm & waterproof clothing (if
wet or cold weather forecast), human backpack, food & drink, sunscreen, hat, insect repellent, etc.

NOTE: WALKERS MUST CARRY THEIR OWN FIRST AID ITEMS.

Please pre-load & weigh your dog's backpack to roughly the correct weight at home.

Weather policy: Weather policy is in accordance with the ANCK Sled Sports Rules and Dogs Victoria extreme weather policy.
Hikes must not be commenced or conducted at any time the forecast or actual temperature exceeds 25°C.
The event may also be cancelled if severe weather conditions are predicted for the event area.
