GENERAL CONDITIONS: All trials will be conducted in accordance with the A.N.K.C./Dogs Australia Rules for the conduct of Retrieving Trials for Gundogs. A copy of the rules will be available at the fixture.

Firearms Licence/Shooters Licence details are required on ALL ENTRY FORMS and electronic entries.

If, at close of entries there are insufficient entries to hold a Stake, competitors will be notified. At that time they may request a refund of entry fee, or if eligible, transfer to another Stake at the appropriate fee.

Dogs SA Extreme Weather and Safety Rules apply. If forecast 48 hours prior for Retrieving, Field and RATG; is 32 degrees Celsius or higher must be cancelled, unless there is ample swimming on the property. The Trial site is Private Property and must not be revisited following the Trial.

Dogs SA Rules PART VIII EXHIBITIONS C 15. (b) There is to be no training on designated trial grounds within 28 days before trial.

RAFT Covid Plan applicable.

Other than in the Exercise Areas designated by the Trial Manager, or his/her delegates, no dogs will be permitted to swim or train in or on the trial grounds. All dogs must be kept on a lead, either held in the hand or tethered, except when competing or being exercised in the designated area. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to find out where the exercise area is at any time on the trial grounds.
