**Please note:** Maximum 2 entries per person (DV Membership)  
**Class:** 100m Sprint (Ensure that your dog's height is noted in the memo in Showmanager, dogs not officially measured must be measured during check-in to be eligible to run)

**Check in/ Vetting (bitches only):** 7:30 am – 8 am

**Briefing:** 8:15 am

**Judging Time:** 8:30 am

Measuring will be conducted during check-in for dogs that do not have a height card or are under the age of two, The Catching Pen system will be in use

All Entries MUST have a catcher and/or releaser, entrants to organise this.

Please ensure both handlers have a lead.

- Entries capped at 120
- Judges and Officials can compete and are included in the cap number. The committee reserves the right to close entries early if entries reach a high number
- If the temperature is forecast for 32°C the night before the event on the BOM website, then the event will commence half an hour earlier with a designated break in the PM.

Refer to the rules for the heat policy.

- Consider the fitness of your dog, and ensure all dogs are warmed up before each run
- Dogs can run with a flat collar (no hanging tags) or naked
- Dogs unsuccessful in their first run cannot have a second run until the conclusion of the qualifying dog runs (if time permits)
- Pass cards will be available after Run 2
- Qualifying and title sashes are only available
