EXHIBIT/DOGS The SprintDog™ Trial is open to all breeds registered on the main, limited, sports and associate registers. In compliance with Dogs Australia Rules, the SprintDog™ Trial shall be open to all dog breeds 12 months of age or older on the day of the Trial.

CHECK IN 9.00am – 9.30am

Check in during this time and collect your numbers. Any numbers that are not collected during this time will be scratched and will not be able to compete in the trial.

VETTING 9.00am – 9.30am

All bitches (Including desexed) must be vetted before the official start time of the SprintDog™ Trial. Bitches in season and/or showing a discharge characteristic of being in season shall not be eligible to compete in a SprintDog™ Trial. and may not be in the trial precinct.

MEASURING 9.00am – 9.30am

If you do not hold an official SprintDog™ Height Card, you must have your dog measured regardless of whether your dog has been measured for any other disciplines. Dogs not officially measured before the trial starts cannot enter the trial. Measuring will be conducted during check-in for dogs that do not have a SprintDog™ height card or are under the age of two.

BRIEFING: 9.45am

All entrants and handlers are required to attend the briefing.

JUDGING 10.00am

The trial will be officially started by the Trial Judge.

CATCHING AREA Enclosed catching pen system will be in use.

CATCH/RELEASE HANDLERS Each entry is to organise their own catcher and release handler. Please ensure both the catcher and releaser handlers each have a lead.

All Owners and Catch/Release handlers must be financial members of Dogs Victoria (or ANKC member body). Membership numbers of all handlers must be listed in memo section on Show Manager entry. Enclosed footwear and weather appropriate clothing must be worn by catch and release handlers.

COLLAR Only one item of permitted restraint is allowed on the dog. Dogs may run with or without a correctly fitted flat collar. Any item attached to the collar (such as name tags, council tags) must be taped up so that it is unable to be caught in the string. No check chains, haltis, prong collars e-collars and/or martingale collars are permitted. Dogs must not run in a harness or any other restraint other than a collar.

AWARDS Qualifying Title – Sash. Qualifying Pass – Ribbon. Pass cards.

PRESENTATION At end of trial, after the pack up of trial equipment has been completed.

DISABILITY/HEALTH CONCERNS If you have a disability, hearing impairment, vision impairment or health condition, please contact the Trial Secretary to discuss your personal requirements prior to the day of the trial. On the day of the trial, allow time to meet with Trial Secretary prior to check in, unless other arrangements have been made.

White Swiss Shepherd Dog Association of Victoria Inc is affiliated with Dogs Victoria.

This trial will be held under the rules and regulations of Dogs Australia and Dogs Victoria.

Judges and Officials may enter and/or handle dogs in this trial and are included in the cap.

The Committee retains the right to close entries early if entries reach a high number or the cap.

Weather - If the temperature is forecast for 32 degrees Celsius the night before the event on the BOM website, the event will commence half an hour earlier with a designated break in PM.

Extreme Weather – Dogs Victoria Extreme Weather Regulations will apply to this event.
