No changes on entries after 12:01am Friday 5 January 2026. **No Refunds** on entries after 12:01am 14 January 2026

Entry fee: Members - \$20. Non Member - \$25



Online entries only, via Showmanager (Registry dogs only)** Entries capped at 60 total. This is *including* the official's dogs.

LIMITED ENTRY - 2 dogs per household, per account.

Lure Drivers: Belinda Mitchell (NSW)

This trial will be using a continuous lure and have an enclosed catching pen.

Check-in: 6:30pm – 7:15pm. Anyone not checked in will be marked absent.

Briefing: 7:30pm

Judging Commences: 8:00pm (may be delayed due to temperature).

Measuring Dogs: Owners will need to fill in the height card before presenting the dog for measurement.

Blank height cards will be available on the day.

Vetting: There will be no vetting at check-in, but organisers reserve the right to vet any dog if it deems

necessary.

Bitches in season are not allowed to compete or allowed on club grounds

Run Order: Run 1 for Officials dogs then all other dogs, followed by Run 2 in the same order.

Catalogue / running sheet: provided free on Showmanager.

- **Dogs must have their showmanager profile linked to the Dogs Aust registry to be entered.
- The Main Officials dogs are included in the entry cap number.
- Ballot will close 09.00am Monday 5th January 2026.
- Once the draw has happened, everyone will receive an email advising if they are successful or unsuccessful. A maximum of 2 dogs will be allowed.
- If successful you will need to complete your entry and pay by 9am Fri 9th January 2026.
- Unpaid entries will be removed and a new ballot done to fill vacancies.
- Withdrawals will be allowed until 9am Wednesday 14th January 2026.
- No refunds after that date.
- Dogs that win the ballot are the dogs that are entered, **Changes will not be made**.
- Entries breaching the rules may be rejected from the ballot.
- All dogs will run in the first round. Dogs that do not complete the course, will not be eligible to compete in the second round.
- Exhibitors to bring their dogs height card. Dogs without a card to be measured at check-in.
- Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers.
- All handlers must be financial members of their state member body. Handlers must be over 16 years of age.
- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in showmanager to aid with cataloguing.
- Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete.
- The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.
- The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.
- This trial is run under the rules & regulations of Dogs NSW.
