Alphabetical as per regulations

- Show 1 (Friday) will be Judged in the 1-4 System ANKC reg Part 5 Section 8.
 - Group 4 followed by Group 2
 - Brace followed by Veteran will be held at the end of each group judging (not judged at the end of the breed). Brace followed by Veteran Sweepstakes at the beginning of General Specials for each group winner.
- Show 2 (Saturday) - Ordinary Judging System
 - Group 2 followed by Group 4
- Show 3 (Sunday) - Ordinary Judging System
 - Group 4 followed by Group 2
 - Breeders Team will be held at the end of each group judging (not judged at the end of the breed) and at the beginning of General Specials for each group winner.

The working party reserve the right to re-allocate breeds between judges should numbers warrant.

Breeders Team: Must consist of four dogs - six months of age and over of the same breed, bred under one prefix each of which has competed in at least one other breed class or neuter class at the same show.

Brace: For two dogs each six months of age and over, of the same breed, each of which has competed in at least one other breed class or neuter class at the sanctioned show and each of which is registered in the same ownership and are handled in the judging ring by one person.

Veteran: 7 years and over. (can be entire or neuter) – don't need to be entered in breed class

Order of Judging: Each of the above special classes will be judged at group level, and the group winner will then compete for in show. Judging of the in show will commence prior to Best in Show judging.

REFRESHMENTS will be available

PLEASE NOTE: Entrants entering more than one dog, will have ALL their entries refunded and will have to start again as will entries known to be multiples from the same household.

Refunds are at the discretion of the working party except if the event is canceled so should not be expected. Prior to the run sheet being finalized we will attempt to refund you if your bitch is in season or you or your dog is unexpectedly injured or you are called in to work. Refunds will be considered if you are able to replace your dog with a waitlist entry prior to the final run-sheet being completed.

If spaces are still available within 3 days of close of ONLINE Close Cate, an additional Dog may be added per household ONLINE at that time only. A notice will be posted on the Western Classic Facebook page.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!!!!! WAITLIST ENTRIES: These will only be accepted only after the initial cap has been reached and only accepted and operate in the following way:

1. Eligible only to entrants that missed out on entering at least one dog from their household due to initial online cap being reached.
2. Accepted via email only: westernclassic@outlook.com
3. Subject line should include- "SprintDog™ Waitlist Entry"
4. A fully completed and legible manual entry form is to be attached to the email for the one dog you wish to waitlist.
5. Your email should include who you are and your best contact details if they are different to those listed on your entry form, so should we be able to offer you an entry, we can alert you.
6. You will be updated with your position in the waitlist as often as possible. Should you be within 1-4th in line, be prepared to transfer payment of your entry. You will be emailed the details to do this. If you do not make payment as requested, the slot will be offered to the next in line.
7. The trial secretary will do the initial run sheet after close of online entries to ensure the main entry can be split up to suit those in working roles and handlers. Any slots made available, will have their position filled by a waitlist entry to the best we can place you.

PLEASE NOTE: Incomplete, illegible or waitlist entries not meeting the above criteria will be refused. All dogs must be measured at Check-in unless previously measured by officials and a Valid official height card for each dog is presented at Check-In station.

Dogs that are excused or Disqualified in Run 1 will not Run in Run 2. Each dog MUST have a Handler to release and another to Catch - Please advise in the Memo's if you are handling another Entrant's dog as well as your Own so we can separate you in the Run Order. ** Run order will stay the same but in order to not waste slots, the working party the right to replace any vacant slot prior to the start should anyone have to cancel or a breach of entry is confirmed.

^Working Party / Trainees / Official Volunteers actively participating in the event will be given a private link to enter one dog prior to the main entry opening and may enter a second dog once the main entry opens. To register as an Official volunteer please email the below email address by Sunday 1st February 2026, it will be first in first served. When emailing please include the role you wish to volunteer for and if you intend on entering a dog.
