This SprintDog Trial is open to all breeds of dog that are VCA registered and whose owners are VCA members.

All handlers, if not the owner of the dogs, must also be members of the VCA.

Dogs must be over 12 months of age.

Check in/Vetting (bitches): 7.30am to 8.00am

Briefing: 8:15am

Judging Time: Commences at 8.30am.

Measuring will be conducted at check-in for dogs that do not have a height card or are under the age of two.

Entries to be made via Show Manager

Catching Pen System will be in use. All entries must nominate a catcher and a releaser – entrants to organise this. Please ensure both handlers have a clip, slip or quick release lead.

Conditions of Entry:

- Judges and officials can compete
- The committee reserves the right to appoint an additional or substitute judge if necessary.
- Dogs must compete wearing a fixed collar with NO tags or no collar (naked).
- The committee reserves the right to close entries early if entries reach the cap
- 40 places will be kept for HVCV members who have been financial members prior to 31/12/2025 – 3 entries per DV membership for HVCV members (one of which must be a Vizsla). The club reserves the right to remove any entries that do not meet this condition.
- Member entry – 18th February 2026, non-member entry – 21st February 2026.
- If member entry is not filled, the remaining spots will be opened to other competitors.
- 2 entries per DV membership for non-members.
- Please nominate your catcher and releaser on your entry
- Entries are capped at 120 dogs.
- Consider the fitness of your dog. Ensure all dogs are warmed up before and cooled down after each run
- Dogs unsuccessful in their first run, cannot have a second run until after conclusion of qualifying dog runs (if time permits)
- Pass cards will be available after Run 2.
- Qualifying ribbons and title sashes available.
- Please notify the trial secretary if you would like a physical QC in the notes section of Show Manager.
