### **EXHIBIT/DOGS**

This Lure Sanctioned Event is open to all breeds registered on the main, limited, sports and associate registers. In compliance with Dogs Australia Rules this event shall be open to all dog breeds 15 months of age or older on the day of the event.

The Sighthound Stream is for dogs recognised as Sighthounds under sections 4.3 and 4.4  
The Lure Pursuit Stream is for all other participating dogs

### **LURE COURSING TESTS/TRIALS AND LURE PURSUIT TESTS ((LPT)**

A test is an event at which Junior Courser, Singles Sighthound and Lure Pursuit tests are conducted. A trial is an event at which Open and Field Champion Classes are conducted. A Sanctioned Event is an event at which both tests and trials may be conducted.

## SIGHTHOUNDS

Afghan Hound, Azawakh, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Deerhound, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Saluki, Sloughi and Whippet. Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Basenjis are considered eligible breeds for the purposes of Lure Sanctioned Events and shall be eligible for the Sighthound titles.

## ALL OTHER BREEDS

Registered with the Member Body on main, limited, sports and associate registers are eligible to participate in Lure Pursuit Tests (LPT)

## LURE PURSUIT STREAM CLASSES (REPLACES CAT CLASSES)

Junior Pursuit (JP), Lure Pursuit (LP), Lure Pursuit Advanced (LPA), Lure Pursuit Excellent (LPE), Lure Pursuit Master (LPM)

## SIGHTHOUND STREAM CLASSES

Junior Courser (JC), Single, Qualifying Course (QC), Open and Field Champion (FCh) Field Champion being for Open dogs that have achieved their Field Champion title.

## VETTING

All bitches (Including desexed) must be vetted before the official start time of the event. Bitches in season and/or showing a discharge characteristic of being in season shall not be eligible to compete in a Lure Coursing or Lure Pursuit event. and may not be in the event precinct.

## MUZZLE REQUIRED

Effective 1 January 2026, all hounds competing in the Open or Field Champion Classes in a Brace or Trio are required to wear a muzzle. Muzzles must be firm and with sufficient strength to prevent injury, A correctly fitted muzzle should be 2-2.5cm clear of the nose and with a depth sufficient for breathing and panting. Muzzles can be made from plastic, nylon or similar material.

Sighthounds - Best in Field Ribbon, Placing Ribbons 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place.  
Qualifying Certificates, Title sashes for all titles gained.

Lure Pursuit – Top Scoring Lure Pursuit Ribbon, Top Scoring Lure Associate/Sporting Ribbon,  
Placing Ribbons 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place.  
Qualifying Certificates, Title sashes for all titles gained.
