Judging commences at 10.30 am or directly after the Breed Survey.

CONFORMATION CLASSES: Baby Puppy - 3 months and under 6 months, Minor Puppy - 6 months and under 9 months, Puppy - 9 months and under 12 months, Junior - 12 months and under 18 months, Intermediate - 18 months and under 24 months, Open - 24 months and over.

JUDGING TIMES: Vest collection from 10.00 am. Judging commences at 10.30 am or directly following the Breed Survey. Sires Progeny, Dams Progeny, Breeders Group, LSC Dogs (Excluding Open Dogs), SC Dogs (Excluding Open Dogs), Veterans Parade, LSC Bitches, SC Bitches, LSC and SC Open Dogs. Junior Handlers will be judged during lunch break.

SIRES AND DAMS PROGENY PARADE: Entry is automatic. A minimum of 5 progeny aged 4 months or over and entered in Conformation classes will be automatically catalogued with the Sires/Dams name. Sire/Dam need not be present or entered in the show. Only Sires/Dams classified under the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme (or other GSDCA-approved scheme) are eligible.

BREEDERS GROUP: Each Breeders Group must consist of four (4) animals from more than one sire or dam and be 9 months or older.

VETERANS PARADE: Dogs must be 7 years or older and may be entered on the day. This is a non-competitive class. Please supply a short resume of your animal's achievements to accompany the entry form.

GRADINGS: Will be awarded at the Judge's discretion: 'Promising' and 'Very Promising' in Baby, Minor and Puppy classes. 'Good' and 'Very Good' in Junior, Intermediate and Open classes. The gradings of 'Excellent' and 'Excellent Merit' will only be awarded to exhibits 24 months and over that are Breed Survey classified and entered in the Open classes. In accordance with GSDCA guidelines, open animals will be subject to a gun test and complete an off-lead gaiting exercise.

Please note:

- The titles of Sieger and Siegerin will be awarded at the Judge's discretion to an animal successfully classified through the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme, or one recognised by the GSDCA, that the judge considers to be of high anatomical worth, type, quality and have a potential for or have demonstrated attributes that will produce animals that are of above, or far above average, in the terms of type and quality.
- There is no inter-sex or inter-variety competition at this show.
- Exhibits over 2 years of age must enter the Open class and forward a copy of the 5-generation pedigree and a copy of the Hip/Elbow Status. Legible paperwork must be received by close of entries, otherwise entry will be rejected. No entry fee for Veterans Parade or Breeders Group.

Baby Puppy - Initial entry \$28.00, Subsequent \$23.00.
