Measuring Dogs:

Don't forget your height card

If you don't have a height card issued by a Dogs Australia sport yet, measuring will be 7:00 to 7:45am at Check-in. Please fill in the height card before presenting the dog for measurement.

Judging starts: 8:15am start but may be delayed due to frost or fog.

- Run Order:**
- Run 1 for Officials dogs, followed by Part A dogs then Part B dogs
 - Run 2 for Official's dogs, followed by Part A dogs then Part B dogs
- Vetting:** No official vetting. The Club reserves the right at their discretion to vet any dog on the rounds.
- Bitches in oestrus may not be trialed.
- Prizes:** Qualifying & Title Gained sashes
- Extreme weather:** 0407 837 150
- Camping:** Available on grounds
- Catalogue and updates:** Posted on Club and SprintDog™ NSW group Facebook page

The Club reserves the right to appoint or substitute additional judges as necessary.

***Ballot system**

- Entries breaching the rules may be rejected from the ballot.
- No dog can run in both Part A and Part B.
- All dogs will run in the first round. Dogs that do not complete the course, will not be eligible to compete in the second round.
- Exhibitors to bring their dogs height card. Dogs without a card to be measured at Check-in.
- Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers.
- All handlers must be financial members of their state member body. Handlers must be over 16 years of age.
- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in Show Manager to aid with cataloguing.
- Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete.
- The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.
- The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.
- This trial is run under the rules & regulations of Dogs NSW.
- Entries into Part A are restricted to people living within the area identified below (0km to 250km from Tamworth). The address listed in Show Manger will be used to accept or reject entries.




Figure 1 – Part A entries restricted to entrants living within 250km of Tamworth
