CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **All Star Dog Sports Club trials are held in the spirit of Good Sportsmanship. Misconduct per the show regulations WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**
- The Club reserves the right to make any changes that will ensure the smooth conduct of the trial, to substitute or appoint additional judges, and to accept or reject entries. Dogs NSW regulations allow contracted judges to compete in the trials, provided they do not do so in the classes they have been contracted to judge.
- These trials shall be conducted in accordance with the recommendations of Dogs NSW and the ANKC. Any additional requirements will be available on the Club's Facebook page and will be made available to all entrants. All officials, competitors and attendees shall agree to abide by the direction of Club Officials in relation to enforcing Club and trial requirements.
- Competitors must only enter the classes they are eligible for
- No upgrades will be allowed after the trial closing date.
- **ALL** Competitors must be able to act as a safety steward/steward for at least one other competitors track.
- The committee reserves the right to substitute judges or add to the judging panel should the entry be excessive.
- **ALL** Competitors **MUST** supply one person to act as a track layer on the day for either yourself if its a known track or another competitor for an unknown track.
- Please note the name of your helper on your entry. These helpers do not need to be experienced, as experienced people will direct them.
