**Other:**

Competitors will need to submit one entry for each class/element. If you are running two dogs in the same class, you **must** specify the second handler's name on your entry form. Competitors from the same household will run back-to-back.

It is the competitor's responsibility to only enter classes that they are eligible to enter. Refer to s6.1 Titling Classes and s6.2 Progression through the Titling Classes of the 'Rules' (specifically s6.2.2 and s6.2.3) for eligibility requirements.

Competitors **should not** visit, bring any odour or train on the school grounds prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and as such visiting these areas may risk contaminating the area or losing the opportunity to use the locations for future events.

No odour is to be brought or used at the trial by competitors on the day.

Competitors **must** park, crate and walk their dogs in designated area only. Please note that competitors not adhering to these rules may be asked to leave the grounds.

**For the safety of all competitors, please ensure that your dog is on lead at all times including leaving your vehicle. Only dogs who have entered the search area where an off-lead option is available are permitted to run off lead.**

No bitches on oestrus are permitted at the trial.

The club reserves the right to make any changes that will ensure the smooth conduct of the trial, including substitute or appoint additional judges, to accept or reject entries and to adjust the starting times. Dogs ACT regulations allow contracted judges to compete in trials provided that they don't do so in the classes that they have been contracted to judge.

If you or your dog is unwell or have recently tested positive for COVID or any other infectious diseases then please do not attend the event, we value our competitors, volunteers and canine companions, so please don't make them unwell.
