Judging starts: 8:15am start, but may be delayed due to frost or fog.

Run Order:

- Run 1 for Official's dogs, followed by Competitor's dogs
- Run 2 for Official's dogs, followed by Competitor's dogs

Vetting:

No official vetting. The Club reserves the right at their discretion to vet any dog on the rounds.

Bitches in oestrus may not be trialed.

- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in Show Manager to aid with cataloguing.
- Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete.
- The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.
- The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.
- This trial is run under the rules & regulations of Dogs NSW.
- Entries open 11 May 2026 at 9am

Entries close 9am Friday 10 July 2026
