Entries open 1 August 2026. Online entries via Show Manager Ballot system

First round Ballot drawn: 8 September 2026 (Payment due by 9.00am 10 September 2026)

Second round Ballot drawn: 14 September 2026 (Payment due by 9.00am 16 September 2026)

Those who are successful will be notified by email (Show Manager). Any withdrawals must be made by 22 September 2026. No refunds or changes after this time.

Entry Fees: \$25 per dog. (Maximum 2 entries per household)

Check-in/Measuring: 7 am – 7.30 am

Briefing: 7.45 am

Judging Commences: 8.00am

Vetting: No formal vetting will be conducted; however, the Club reserves the right to vet any dog in the trial precinct.

Catalogue: Available on Show Manager and "SprintDog™ NSW" Facebook Group

Awards: Qualifier – Ribbon and Certificate (via Show Manager)

Title Gained – Sash

All dogs must be "Registry Dogs" with their Show Manager profile linked to the Dogs Australia database
Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers. Releaser and Catcher must be nominated when entering and must be financial members of DOGS NSW (or equivalent state body) and over 16 years of age
Both Catcher and Releaser must have leads for the dog
Exhibitors must present the dog's height card at check-in. Dogs without a card will be measured at check-in. Blank cards will be available on the day
All eligible dogs will compete in Run 1. Dogs that are excused or disqualified in Run 1 are ineligible to compete in Run 2
Please warm up dogs away from the Sprint Zone and exclusion areas
Bitches in season are NOT allowed to compete or be in the area
Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete
The Club reserves the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the event, to cap entry numbers and to accept or reject entries
