10:00am – 10.30am: Friday, Saturday and Sunday for day tests

NOTE: At Time of Check in. Stamped Competitor numbers to be placed in track reward pack once check in completed.

JUDGING TIMES: Commencing Judging at 6:30 pm for night tests,
Commencing Judging at 11am for day tests,

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

No requests for upgrades will be taken after Monday 31 August 2026. Please email upgrade requests to Trial@gsdcv.org.au (or use Showmanager to edit test details before entries close on Monday 31 August 2026.)

Note: Judges and Stewards are permitted to enter and will be judged before commencement of other competitor tests.

Note: It is the handler responsibility to ensure correct equipment available for their dog and themselves before starting track. Handlers are expected to wear reflective vests and head lamps (for night tracks) as outlined in the ANKC Rules and Guidelines. No Trackons will be provided. **Please also note if Test 1, your track layer should present at the GSDCV Rooms 30 minutes before Checkin starts to enable tracklayer to be sent out if required by Judge.**

The GSDCV reserves the right to start the trial earlier or add additional judges if entries warrant.

Note: To ensure all competitors know when their test is scheduled, the Trial Catalogue will be provided to the competitor by email once catalogue finalised. A valid email address must be provided with entry. The catalogue will then be posted on GSDCV website by Wednesday 9 September 2026.

Please note: Track and Search Trials require many more helpers due to the numbers of diversion tracklayers, minglers and extra stewards required by the rules. We are hoping not to have to ballot, but we will be forced to if we do not have enough helpers. **We request that every competitor provides at least one helper or volunteers themselves for a day they are not tracking.** These helpers do not need to be experienced, as experienced people will direct them. Please do not nominate helpers on the day they are tracking themselves. **Please note the name of your helper on your entry. Helpers who are available for two or more days are most useful.**

Awards Presentations made at conclusion of a session.

Title Sash & Pass Card or Qualifying ribbon & Pass card available for qualifying test.

Registered GSDs are eligible for GSDCV Grading Certificates for qualifying tests and GSDCA Excellent Medallions where an Excellent grading is achieved
