- Entries:** Open 20 July 2026 via **SHOWMANAGER ONLY**. Close 9 August 2026 6pm – no refunds after this date.
Entries capped at 40 entries per day (Including volunteers)
- Location:** Belmont Wetlands State Park Campground
119 Kalaroo Road, Redhead (via main entrance) 2WD accessible
- Camping:** Book online www.belmontwetlands.com.au. SBCNSW has reserved campsites for the Trial. Use booking code: SBCNSW. Observe ALL vehicle rules.
- Weigh in:** 5.45am – 6.30am (both days)
- Briefing:** 6.45am (both days)
- Hike Commences:** 7.00am (both days) Allow 5-7hrs, including at least 2 rest stops, and lunch break of 30mins – maps provided on hike day.
- Presentation:** at conclusion of hike, after backpacks re-weighed and validated.
Qualifying sash, Title sash, Certificate (via Show Manager)
- Entry fees:** Members: \$45 Non-Members: \$50 per dog
Membership discount will be checked. Incorrect entries will be returned

Entry Requirements:

Eligibility: Restricted to ANKC registered dogs eighteen months of age and over at Trial date. Handlers must be 16yrs and over and current members of their state canine control body, and show membership card if requested. Both dog and handler need to be fit. Dog must be able to carry either the 15% (WNPd) or 30% (WPD) pack weight over 16km distance each day. Judge's decision is final if either a dog or handler is deemed not being able to cope with hike conditions, and be withdrawn. Hikers will move in convoy on all routes. **HIKERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A HI-VIS SAFETY VEST AND BE VISIBLE TO THE CONVOY AND ROAD USERS.** Judge will be walking with the group. Further instructions will be provided at the briefing.

Maximum 2 dogs household membership (includes kennel, single or joint)

Weight: Dogs weighing over 10 kg are eligible. **Exclusions:** Brachycephalic & Achondroplastic breeds

What to bring: **SUFFICIENT WATER AND FOOD FOR YOURSELF AND YOUR DOG, YOUR OWN 1ST AID KIT AND COMPASS.** Lead (no longer than 2m) & a flat collar; your dog's pre-loaded & pre-weighed backpack to roughly the correct weight at home (pack will be weighed for correct weight before hike commences each day), water & water bowl for your dog, waste bags, appropriate clothing & footwear, warm & waterproof clothing and footwear (if wet or cold weather forecast), human backpack, food & drink, sunscreen, hat, insect repellent, high-vis vest etc.

If temperature exceeds 25°C, event will be cancelled (Ch 3, S 18). Event will go ahead in wet weather (excl flooding)
