Second round ballot may be run if required.



**Judging Commences** 9.00 am

**Check in:** 8.00 – 8.30 am

**Briefing:** 8.45 am

**Vetting:** There will be no formal vetting, but the Club reserves the right to vet any dog on the grounds at any time. Bitches in Oestrus may not be on the grounds.

**Entry Fees:** \$20.00 per entry Members or \$25 Non Members(max 2 entries per household)

**Catalogues:** Available online prior on SprintDog™ NSW Facebook page and on Show Manager

**Refreshments:** BYO, showground café may be open

**PRIZES:** Qualifiers: Ribbon Title gained: Sash Certificates: Show Manager

- SHK&OC reserves the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial, to cap entry numbers or to accept or reject entries.
- Dogs must have their Show Manager profile linked to the Dogs Australia database IE be a registry dog.
- Exhibitors must arrange own handlers. You must nominate a catcher and releaser when entering and both must be financial members of a Dogs Australia body and over 16 years of age.
- A maximum of two dogs per household may be entered. Should an exhibitor successful in the round 1 ballot not be able to enter the trial, the entry goes back in for the round 2 ballot. The exhibitor has no rights to allocate that entry to anyone else.
- Both releaser and catcher require a separate lead (2 leads per dog)
- Exhibitors are to bring the dog's height card to check-in. Dogs without a height card will be measured at check-in or given a handicap of 1. Please complete a height card before presenting for measuring. Blank cards available on the day.
- All eligible dogs may attempt run 1. Dogs that are unsuccessful in run 1 will be disqualified from run 2.
- Please warm up dogs away from the Sprint and exclusion zones.
- Bitches in whelp or less than 10 weeks post-partum are not permitted to compete.
