COVID SAFE PROCEDURES

WELCOME all exhibitors, judges, officials, quests and visitors to the 59th ISCV INC. Championship Show.

This event will be run according to Victorian Government Current COVID restrictions and Dogs Victoria advice.

We are relying on your cooperation to have a great show whilst ensuring that everyone present is safe and operates in a safe manner.

BEFORE THE SHOW

- All attendees' names must be registered via Show Manager or with show secretary rhonda.fisher@optusnet.com.au by 17th April. . After this date please complete the Attendee Register near the Show Secretaries office BYO pen.
- Please be familiar with the COVID Education Exhibitors, Competitors and Members and COVID Education - Physical Examination of a Dog sections of the Dogs Victoria COVID-19 Update Hub at https://dogsvictoria.org.au/members.
- Each attendee is asked to do a **symptom self-assessment** prior to leaving home and not attend if they are unwell or have a temperature or have been instructed to isolate or quarantine.
- Every attendee must **Carry a Mask** with them, in case it is required at any stage during the day, Every attendee needs to have their own **personal hand sanitizer**
- 1. There is no catering so please bring food (unless organising Takeaway delivery) drinks and chair.
- Exhibitors should bring poo bags for their dogs.
- The pre ordered and complimentary physical catalogues will be available at the secretaries office from 8.45.

- Exhibit numbers must be printed at home or blank Spares will be available at ring side BYO pen.
- Attendee sheet must be printed at home to hand to gate marshal. If the car contains additional
 people please add their details and delete any people that are not attending.

UPON ARRIVAL

- THE GATE WILL NOT OPEN TO EXHIBITORS UNTIL 8AM.
- On arrival, cars will be directed through the gate, please have the attendee printed out to hand to the gate marshal this will make entry fast. If the attendee sheet has been altered, tell the gate marshal so they can facilitate the recording of each person on the Attendee Register.
- Your ring location is group 4 near the Show Secretaries Office
- **Gazebos and mats must be 1.5 metres apart on all sides.** Gazebos with more than one side cannot have non family members and remember social distancing.

DURING SHOW

NEW RULES APPLY:

THE USE OF MASKS FOR JUDGES AND EXHIBITORS ARE PERSOAL CHOICE.

- A face mask should be carried by everyone throughout the day, in case it is required when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- COVID Marshal is there to ensure everyone's compliance, safety and that a happy, successful day is had. Please see James if you have questions.
- Covid Marshal instructions MUST be followed at all times, if the instructions are not followed the
 offending person will be referred to the Show Manager. They will be required to leave the event and
 will be reported to Dogs Victoria.
- Attendees must maintain at least 1.5m physical distance from others at all times, except during the
 physical examination of their exhibit in the ring.
- Exhibitors will mouth their own exhibits for the judge
- Masks are not mandatory for the exhibitor and judge during the close physical assessment of each exhibit.
- Masks are not mandatory during the rest of the time in the ring (stacking, moving as a class and individually)
- Judges will hand sanitize between physical examination of exhibits
- All exhibitors will enter the ring via the entry point and leave via the exit. Any changeover of dogs will
 take place in a coordinated, safe way, without rush or pressure, outside the ring
- All exhibitors must use their own bags to pick up any dog poo. There will be spare bags at the Office, for emergencies
- Please refrain from entering other exhibitors' gazebos.
- Any personal equipment, e.g. brushes and leads, shared by handlers, must be sanitized between users.
- Any issues should be dealt with via the COVID Marshal who can make contact with the Show Manager if necessary
- Please do not return presented place ribbons, they are to be kept by the exhibitor.
 Club Prizes, sashes, challenges and cards will be presented at the ring
- Toilets will be available inside the exhibition centre northern door. Please adhere to correct social distancing whilst using them
